john k. HATCH

John Hatch, famous for innovating village banking, is an American economic development expert and modern-day microfinance pioneer.

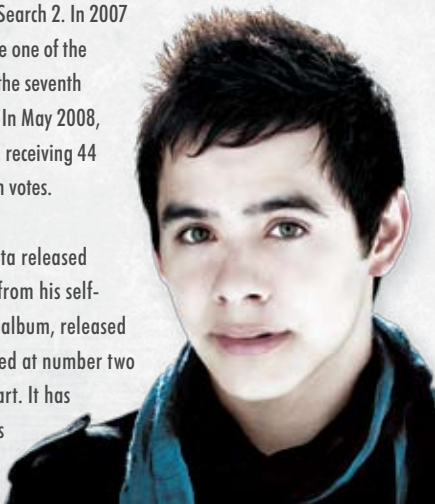
In 1984 Hatch created his own nonprofit agency, the Foundation for International Community Assistance (FINCA), outlining a financial services program that placed the poor in charge. The means to achieving this purpose were “village banks,” a self-managed support group of some 25 borrower-owners. It provided the poorest families with loans to finance self-employment activities that could generate additional income. FINCA currently operates village banking programs in 23 countries.

In 2006, Hatch retired from day-to-day operations at FINCA headquarters, although he continues to support FINCA in his capacity as a board member, fundraiser, and guest lecturer at universities.

david ARCHULETA

David James Archuleta is an American pop singer-songwriter, bestselling author and occasional actor. At age twelve, Archuleta was the Junior Vocal Champion on Star Search 2. In 2007 at age sixteen, he became one of the youngest contestants on the seventh season of American Idol. In May 2008, he finished as runner-up, receiving 44 percent of over 97 million votes.

In August 2008, Archuleta released “Crush,” the first single from his self-titled debut album. The album, released two months later, debuted at number two on the Billboard 200 chart. It has sold over 750,000 copies in the U.S. and over 900,000 worldwide.

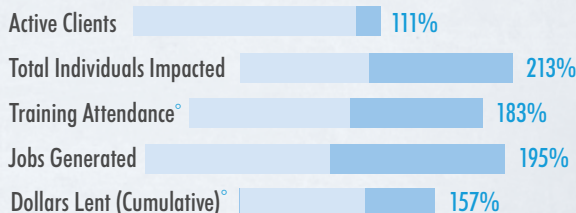
